## **JULY 3 - HOLIDAY FOR ALL CLASSES**

### **REASON FOR TAKING SUMMER SCHOOL COURSES:**

- 1. Retention Requirement:** Remedial courses offered for pupils at risk of retention (7-8). These are mandatory for students who are recommended for retention or retained.
- 2. California High School Exit Exam Courses:** These courses are mandatory for students not demonstrating sufficient progress toward passing the California High School Exit Exam.

**ATTENDANCE:** Students who have more than eight (8) hours of absences during each Summer School session will NOT earn credit in summer school and will be dropped from the class.

**REGISTRATION:** A completed registration form must be submitted to and approved by the student's current counselor by **June 2, 2009**. All students must sign up for summer school if there is a chance they might not pass. All courses are filled in the following priority order:

1. Student status (SDUHSD residents have priority)
2. Proficiency/promotion status (student has not satisfied the district requirements)
3. Graduation status (student has failed a required class needed for graduation)
4. Grade level (12...11...10...9...8...7).
5. Grade improvement (high school only).
6. Date application submitted (on or before **June 2, 2009**).
7. Out-of-District (as space is available).

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**ENROLLMENT:** A confirmation letter and schedule will be mailed to all registered students. This will also confirm location of your class. Every effort will be made to accommodate your preference; however, enrollment will determine site availability.

**DISCIPLINE:** Summer school students are expected to follow the district Code of Conduct. Fighting, cheating, harassment, drug, alcohol or tobacco use, or other offenses will not be tolerated. Students who break the Code of Conduct will be subject to the district's discipline guidelines. Copies of the Code of Conduct can be obtained in the assistant principal's office. Your signature on the registration form indicates your willingness to comply with this agreement.

**TRANSPORTATION:** There will be limited shuttle service to and from all district summer school sites. Transportation schedules are available at all school sites and our website. Bus passes will also be available for purchase at all school sites.

**MATH COURSES:** Summer high school math course material is compacted into three weeks per semester. It is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** that students who need second semester math take first semester math also. **First semester should be taken even if it was passed during the regular school year.** Algebra I graduation requirement mandates all students must pass Algebra I to receive a diploma. **Seniors that have not yet met this requirement are strongly urged to enroll in Algebra I during summer.**

**OUTSIDE ENROLLMENT:** Enrollment for students not attending SDUHSD schools must be done through the Instructional Services Department, District Office.

- For **district** residents attending private schools, the registration packet must accompany the application, including proof of residence and the student's immunization record.
- For **non-district** residents, the registration packet must accompany the application, including the student's immunization record.

Out of district applications from students not residing within SDUHSD boundaries will be filled on a space available basis following enrollment of SDUHSD residents.

**YEAR COURSES:** Session I corresponds to the first semester and Session II to the second semester of a year-long course. For example, if a student needs first semester of a course, he/she must sign up for Session I. English is the only exception. It may be taken either session.

**NOTE:** Courses with insufficient enrollment may be canceled.
