

Re: San Dieguito Public Facilities Authority 2006 Revenue Refunding Bonds

Special tax revenue to be collected for payment on the 2006 Revenue Refunding Bonds in the fiscal year 2015/16 will be \$7,817,757.50. The growth of special taxes continues within the nine-bonded Community Facilities Districts (CFDs) increasing year over year by 2.63% or \$200,380.00 in 2015/2016 compared to 7.71% or \$544,939.50 in 2014/2015.

Permit Activity (2015-2016)

A total of 486 new residential units, including 270 multi-family units, were permitted in 6 of the 9 CFDs in 2015/16. Most of the residential units were permitted in Blackstone Ranch (CFD 94-2), the Elms and the Ivy (CFD 99-1), and Pacific Highlands Ranch (CFD 03-1).




Special Tax Revenue

A total of \$7,817,757.50 in special tax revenue is expected to be collected in the nine Community Facilities Districts in 2015/16. All nine CFDs are bonded for the 2006 Revenue Refunding Bonds.

Special tax revenue will be collected in the following amounts from the Community Facilities Districts.



Delinquency Rates

Delinquencies continue to maintain historic lows. Delinquencies for 2015/16 are 0.4% compared to 0.47% last year.

94-2 Bond Covenant

Pursuant to Section 6.2(b) of the Series 2006 Indenture of Trust, the Authority shall certify annually to the Trustee that each bond year, the Pro Rata Portion of CFD 94-2 in such bond year, together with all prior bond years, shall not exceed the percentage of all monies disbursed (or designated to be disbursed) from the Transferred Project Fund or the Released Project Fund that have been expended (or are designated to be expended) for Qualified 94-2 Facilities.

On August 9, 2006, \$19,227,196.41 was deposited into the Transferred Project Fund. CFD 94-2's pro rata portion was 31.2%, or \$5,998,885.28. Trustee adjustments of \$22,090.77 for interest sweeps and cost of issuance close out increases CFD 94-2's pro rata portion to \$6,020,976.05.

As of July 11, 2016, \$6,676,946.36 has been expended for Qualified 94-2 Facilities. Since the amount expended for Qualified 94-2 Facilities is in excess of CFD 94-2's pro rata portion, no further Acquisition and Construction funds are required to be allocated to a Qualified 94-2 Facility for compliance. Further, as of July 11, 2016, all monies have been expended from the Project Fund.
