


Demographics – Middle Schools








Demographics - Middle Schools








Demographics – Middle Schools






Demographics - Boundary High Schools



History of Financing

- Bond financing plan has evolved over time to address two opposing factors:
 - Improved assessed valuation created more capacity to issue bonds
 - Board direction to restrict bond terms to 25 years without the use of capital appreciation bonds (CABs) reduced bonding capacity
- Net effect has been a lengthening of the timeline for bond issuance and construction:
 - Savings from shorter terms on current interest bonds (CIBs) is offset by inflation incurred in estimated construction costs

Series D - Continued Financing Parameters


- Continued pledge of a tax rate not to exceed \$25.00 per \$100,000 AV.
 (Current tax rate is \$22.29)
- Continued practice of a repayment term not to exceed 25 years per series.
- Continued practice to use a financing plan that eliminates or reduces the use of CABs.
- Increased conservative view of projected yearly AV growth by decreasing the projected growth from 5% to 4%.



Potential Series D-G Bonds (Prop AA)

- The School District would be able to issue the remaining Prop AA authorized amount by 2035 using only Current Interest Bonds
- > Taxable series can be issued in 2018, 2021 and 2025 to pre-fund set-aside QSCB payments in full



Potential 2018 Special Tax Revenue Bonds

- The District could refund the remaining 2008A and 2008B Bonds on a parity basis with the 2016 Bonds on a current basis in May 2018
 - 2016 Bonds would then hold a senior-lien position on parity with 2008A and 2008B Bonds
- Potential economic savings of \$3 million by refunding the 2008A and 2008B Bonds
- New Indenture allows for additional bonds to be issued as well
- Potential new project money of \$7-12 million
