Bonds, Series 2006 A and B Update

As you may be aware, Government Code 6599.1 requires that all issuers selling Marks-Roos bonds, after January 1, 1996 are required to report specific information to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) by October 30th of each year. As such, the following is a summary of that information provided to CDIAC on October 17, 2017. As well, a new rule, Government Code 53343.2 requires that the reports submitted to CDIAC be displayed on the District web site by the end of January 2018.

In that effort, Staff is constructing a new web page dedicated to special taxes that will include the applicable CDIAC reports, reports provided to the State Controller's Office, and an interactive map overlay to allow homeowners, real estate agents, title companies, and others to locate properties within the District and gain information related to special taxes assessed within the District's nine community facilities districts (CFDs), including amount of annual special tax, year of first assessment, and year of final assessment. This web page will support our continued customer service as we continue to directly serve the more than 11,500 units sited on the 9,612 parcels levied.

On July 26, 2006, the SDPFA issued bonds, Series 2006 A&B, in the principal amount of \$91,125,000.00 on behalf of the District's CDFs. On May 6, 2008, the Authority remarketed the bonds in the then outstanding principal amount of \$89,130,000.00. Of the principal amount remarketed, \$71,915,000.00 remains outstanding as of 6/30/17 with the final term ending August 1, 2041.

As required by the Series 2006 bonds, the SDPFA holds a Reserve Fund with the trustee, US Bank, in support of the Series 2006 bonds.

Reserve Fund

Amount Required: \$5,702,432.50 Cash on Account 6/30/17: \$5,708,539.12 Excess Reserves 6/30/17: \$6,106.62

As noted previously, the District's nine CFDs support the Series 2006 bonds, their prorata share of the remarketed principal amount of the bonds is noted below, as well as their prorata share of the outstanding bonds, and budgeted 2016/2017 administrative expense as noted in the CDIAC report. Also included are the audited actual administrative amounts as compiled for the District's audited financial report.
