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#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Pursuant to the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement, it is noted that the Treasurer and Controller of the Authority for the Board does not hold any monies directly, and has not collected any new receipts nor paid out any such receipts directly. All monies continue to be held, collected and distributed by the Trustee, US Bank and from the following accounts and balances thereof as of June 30, 2018:

Amounts held by Trustee, US Bank

Revenue Fund/Obligation Fund 5000 : \$ 137,473.87 Interest Account 5001 : \$ 0.00 Principal Account 5002 : \$ 0.00

Reserve Fund Account 5003 : \$ 1,661,200.00 (surety)

Capital Improvement Fund 5005 : \$ 15,533,066.97

#### **Project Budgets and Status**

The 2016 issuance provided \$22,090,944.18 of building fund proceeds on December 1, 2016. Those proceeds are distributed between the two CFDs accordingly:

CFD 03-1: \$16,552,789.82 CFD 94-2: \$ 5,538,154.36 As well, the proceeds are dedicated towards the following projects, and as revised from the June 7, 2018 meeting savings of \$700,000 from both the Canyon Crest Academy Building B and Solar projects have been redistributed to the Pacific Trails Middle School Building B project for additional audio visual and security infrastructure of \$35,000 and \$665,000 to Perimeter Security for school sites in the South bringing that budget on par with the Perimeter Security budget for school sites in the North. Further, transfers from both general Perimeter Security budgets have been made towards dedicated security projects both district wide, Raptor visitor badging systems, and at specific school sites, Torrey Pines High School and San Dieguito HS Academy, as those plans are developed and carried out.
