Since the last meeting, the installation of security cameras is now complete at Carmel Valley Middle School, Diegueno Middle School, and Oak Crest Middle School. Installation of security cameras is nearing completion at Pacific Trails Middle School; the last of our school sites to receive them. Once completed, staff will resurvey sites for any needed security camera expansion to cover areas either previously under development or not originally considered though now recognized by the school site as needed.

The re-keying of San Dieguito HS Academy campus is now complete, and the re-keying of Torrey Pines High School is in planning with an expected summer start.

Plans for the Torrey Pines High School Torrington embankment project have been finalized and the project is being prepared to be put out to bid. The project is anticipated to start late June 2021 and complete mid-August 2021.

Since the last meeting, the modernization of Oak Crest Middle School Buildings C and I has obtained Division of State Architect approval. The project which includes student support spaces such as speech pathology, and a Flex Lab/Studio for cartooning and ASB, as well as improvements for Special Ed instruction has also been placed out to bid, and since received bids. The low bid is in the process of being submitted for approval and contracting. The project will look to begin construction at the start of May and is expected to complete at the end of July. As Building C is now a component of the larger site modernization its budget and expense has been rolled up into the larger modernization project budget.

Improvements to Crest Hall that may also include the introduction of solar to the campus using the allocated 2016 Bond proceeds are in planning and design with site layouts for solar being developed for consider by the school site and City.

At Torrey Pines High School, the District has received bids for the improvements to the I Building, including the new Makerspace shop, CAD Lab, Digital Arts Lab, and new Food Service area. The bids received placed the project over budget, and rounds of value engineering and scope reduction have taken place reducing the cost by \$1.37 million.

With these reductions in place, select construction, such as minor demolition and abatement has started. The project is expected to complete in December 2021.
