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3. Reconvene / Call to Order(Agenda Item 3) The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to order at 6:43PM by President Deanna Rich. 4. Salute to Flag(Agenda Item 4) Kiran Natarajan led the salute to the flag. 5. Report Out of Closed Session.....(Agenda Item 5) There was no report out of Closed Session. 6. Approval of Minutes(Agenda Item 6) It was moved by Ms. Dalessandro and seconded by Ms. Groth that the Minutes of the March 15, 2007 Board Meeting be approved. Motion unanimously carried. NON-ACTION ITEMS(AGENDA ITEMS 7 - 10) 7. Student Board Member Reports(Agenda Item 7) All students present reported on current events and pending activities at their respective schools. Reported highlights included an update on the number of students at Torrey Pines High School taking the AP test this year, approximately 2,800 to date, and a pending blood drive at San Dieguito Academy, the second one this year. 8. Board Member Reports.....(Agenda Item 8) Ms. Friedman reported on her attendance at foundation fundraiser events for La Costa Canyon and Torrey Pines; her invitation and acceptance to serve on Congressman Billbray's Education Advisory Board; her participation in a recent Parent Rep Site Council meeting; a local superintendents' forum; a teacher recognition event where one of the recepients receving an award was the Adapted PE teacher assigned to Carmel Valley Middle School; and an open house with Assemblymen Garrick and Wyland. Ms. Hergesheimer reported on her attendance at the recent Parent Rep Site Council

meeting; attendance at the foundation fundraising event for La Costa Canyon High School; and campus visitations at Sunset, North Coast and Canyon Crest Academy.

Ms. Groth reported attending a recent San Diego County School Board Association Meeting; the gala foundation fundraiser events for Torrey Pines and La Costa Canyon; the open house with Assemblymen Garrick and Wyland; and an invitation to participate in a San Diego Region Chamber of Commerce meeting with Mr. Wyland and his staff.

Ms. Dalessandro also reported on attending the two high school foundation gala events; a Career Technology workshop organized and presented by SDUHSD staff; and an invitation to score essays written by students at Torrey Pines High School as an application process for scholarships. A total of 162 essays were reviewed by Ms. Dalessandro.

Ms. Rich reported on attending the same foundation gala events for Torrey Pines and La Costa Canyon; the Career Technology workshop; and a San Diego County School Board Association meeting with Asemblyman Garrick.

- 10. La Costa Canyon Update, Amy Souza, Ed.D., Principal..................................(Agenda Item 10) Principal Amy Souza presented a thorough report about La Costa Canyon High School. Topics included an update on academic excellence, plans for future staff development and collaboration, a technology update, student connection and citizenship, and a variety of approaches for communication with students, parents, and the community. Ms. Souza also reported that during a recent Distinguished School Visit, LCC earned a perfect score on the written report. In addition, the committee highlighted features at LCC such as the positive attitude among the students, parents and staff. Ms. Souza concluded her presentation by thanking the Board of Trustees on behalf of the entire LCC staff, for their ongoing support throughout the year and for attending the various events and activities at the school.

Torrey Pines Visual Performing Arts Center, Update, RNT/Steve Ma(Agenda Item 11) Mr. Steve Ma presented an update on the status of the construction plans for the Visual Performing Arts Center at Torrey Pines High School. He also introduced an architect from Roesling Nakamura Terada Architects, the company contracted to assist with the construction project, who discussed details about the Visual and Performing Arts Master Plan. They explained key points such as the proposed location, a list of projects requiring modernization and projects requiring new construction. Also presented was an estimated cost breakdown of all expenses required in order to complete the project. Further updates will follow.
