INSTRUCTIONAL SPECIALIST/BILINGUAL RESOURCE TEACHER, TITLE VII

Primary Function: To assist the Bilingual Title VII Director and site

staffs in the implementation, maintenance and

evaluation of the Title VII project.

Directly Responsible To: Director of Title VII and Assistant Superintendent

The duties of the instructional specialist/Title VII Resource Teacher shall include, but not be limited to, the following::

- 1. Assist the Title VII Director in developing and implementing staff development programs in the area of bilingual education as outlined in the Title VII grant.
- 2. Assist the director in implementing, maintaining and evaluating the Title VII project out of three sites.
- 3. Assist the Title VII site staffs in implementing project goals (inservice, parent education, etc.)
- 4. Assist in the overall education of the bilingual Title VII participants.
- 5. Assist in the preparation of reports required by the federal government.
- 6. Assist the Title VII Director in maintaining articulation, and coordination of programs offerings, grades 7-12.
- 7. Assist in promoting and publicizing the Title VII bilingual program with staff and community.
- 8. Perform other related duties in the area of Title VII as may be assigned by the Title VII Director of Assistant Superintendent.
