PRINCIPAL - SUNSET HIGH SCHOOL

Primary Function: To be responsible for the overall leadership in the

district continuation program.

Directly Responsible To: Superintendent of Schools.

Directly Supervises: Certificated and classified staff of Sunset High

School.

Functional Responsibilities: Assumes, responsibility for the instructional

program, student guidance and counseling program, evaluation of student achievement, and student placement in the continuation program.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Education:

- A. Advanced degree with emphasis in pupil personnel services and administration.
- B. Appropriate supervisory or administrative credential.

2. Experience:

A. At least five years of successful teaching and/or counseling experience.

APPOINTMENT

- 1. The candidate shall be selected by the Board of Trustees on the recommendation of the superintendent.
- 2. The candidate shall be selected from among a list a qualified applicants selected through the medium of interview and examination procedures established by the superintendent.

OPERATIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The superintendent is authorized to develop a job description for the principal, Sunset High School, that will define specific areas of responsibility.

PRINCIPAL - SUNSET HIGH SCHOOL

The operational responsibilities of the principal of Sunset High School shall include but not be limited to the following. The principal:

- 1. Supervises the instructional program at Sunset High School.
- 2. Has responsibility for the preparation of the school preliminary budget and implementation of the necessary approved school budgets.
- 3. Evaluates certificated and classified personnel in the school.
- 4. Provides students with individual and group guidance in matters affecting their personal, social and educational adjustment.
- 5. Provides occupational guidance as per student need.
- 6. Assists students in securing employment and conducts an evaluation concerning each student's job effectiveness.
- 7. Conducts home visits and/or parent conferences in cases where a student is not succeeding in the instructional programs.
- 8. Serves as a member of the student placement committee for the Sunset High School program.
- 9. Compiles and submits the necessary reports as required by local and state law.
- 10. Performs other duties relating to continuation education as assigned by the Superintendent.
